At least three cross-site visits were organised per pilot site in period 1 and 2 (see table below). All the visits were related to the DREEAM work implementation in collaboration with WP1 (Chalmers), WP2 (Exeleria), WP3 (RISE) and WP4 (Savills, SinCeO2, OpenDomo).

The scope of these visits was mainly to:

- gather the necessary information from the pilots;
- installing technical equipment for the monitoring;
- perform quality assurance work;
- conduct interviews with tenants as part of the tenant engagement programme.
